We are extremely grateful for the continued support provided by Deercreek Women's Alliance to ensure all children have access to free vision care—a vital component of primary healthcare. Your support helped us to hold Sight in Schools vision clinics at Greenfield Elementary, a Title I public school in the Deercreek school district in which more than 91% of the students attending are from low-income families. Your gift allowed us to bring the doctor, eye exams, and glasses directly to the students in need.

There was a great need for our vision care services at Greenfield Elementary. During the first half of the 2023-2024 school year, we've held 6 Sight in Schools clinics there, providing a total of 123 students with complete eye exams! All 85 students in need of glasses were able to pick their frames out during the clinic. Now these children are able to see their world clearly! Your support makes this possible!!
